

Plan for first year and handover to elected committee



First efforts:

- Performed by interested initial members in 'acting' roles
- Develop initial version of NGN objectives and constitution
- First events to gather interest and first members
- Aim for sufficient members to vote in new organising committee in 2023
- Initial budget to be approved by CIGRE BE NC
- Social Media Platforms (e.g. LinkedIn, YouTube)
- Announcement mail prepared (including draft flyer, member online registration form)
- Incentives secured:
 - Minimum of two free tickets for 2022 CIGRE Paris Session
 - NGN member registration discounts for 2022 CIGRE Paris Session
 - Students 50% Discount
 - Young Professionals (under 35 years) 20%
 Discount

- Spring 2022: presentation competition
 - To gather NGN members
 - All entrants need to sign up for NGN member
 - Chance to win 2 CIGRE session tickets and prize for winner

Summer & Autumn 2022:


NGN Belgium objectives / mission statement (draft)

- Networking with peers including industry site visits
 - E.g. networking events, industrial visits
- Lowering the barrier for getting into CIGRE
 - Introducing CIGRE to young members and how to get involved (WG)
 - Mentoring program
- Offering young members a platform
 - Showcase competition
 - Access to technical resources (e.g. industry best practices in TBs, NC technical talks/events, tutorials, workshops, etc.)

Steering Committee structure / responsibility (draft)











- Key aim: Gather first members of BE NGN
- Procedure:
 - Call for short presentation abstracts (e.g. <500 words)
 - Best 5 abstracts selected for presentation
 - In person event including presentations, Q&A, networking, and sandwiches
 - Key CIGRE BE NC personnel judge presentations
 - Best presentation->winner gets a prize
 - Two tickets for CIGRE Paris 2022-all new members enter Wheel of Names



3. Spring 2022 Presentation Competition

4. Minimum 2-year membership subsidy for Young Professionals (in case not reimbursed by employers)

- Student membership is free for full time tertiary students
- NGN Individual membership for Young Professionals (<35 + first 2 years of membership) = €48 (already discounted) for 2022
- A general Individual membership = €96 for 2022
- A 2-year subsidy for Young Professionals = €96/person
- CIGRE UK NC offer subsidies to cover first 3 years of membership fees for Young Professionals




Membership rules (draft)

To be voted on when sufficient members gathered (aim: December 2022)

- Elected Officers:
 - Chair, Vice-Chair, Secretary, Treasurer, Events Lead, Communications and Marketing Lead
 - Term of one year. Max two year term
 - Yearly election procedure
- Election
 - At least 20% of NGN members should vote for valid election
 - Yearly (Q4) to decide on steering committee for following year
- The Chair and Treasurer of the NGN shall have a seat on the CIGRÉ Belgium Executive Committee.





- The Chair, Vice-Chair, Secretary, Treasurer, Events Lead, Communications and Marketing Lead and Technical Lead and Academic Liaison Officer are the Elected Officers and shall be elected by NGN Members.
- The term of office of the Chair, Vice Chair, Treasurer, Secretary, Events Lead,
 Communications and Marketing Lead, and Technical Lead and Academic Liaison Officer
 shall be for a period of one year. The appointments may be renewed by election in the
 consecutive year, but the person shall not hold the same position for longer than two
 years total.
- No more than one elected position may be held simultaneously by a single NGN Member.
- The tenure of office of the Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary & Treasurer or Communications Lead shall expire if they cease to be an NGN Member.
- The Chair and Treasurer of the NGN shall have a seat on the CIGRÉ Belgium Executive Committee.





- Meetings to elect officers shall only proceed upon reaching a quorum.
- A quorum is met when the number of votes exceeds 10% of the total membership of the NGN, with votes either in person or through a voting system.
- In the absence of a quorum no election of officers shall be conducted, and it shall be the responsibility of the Chair to set a new voting date as soon as possible. If 3 months have passed without a quorum being reached, the CIGRÉ Belgium NC shall nominate and elect persons to fulfil each role that is available.
- Each NGN Member shall be entitled to one vote per elected position.
- Where matters need to be decided by vote, a simple majority shall be effective.
- In the event of a tie, the Chair shall have the casting vote.
- When in the opinion of the Chair it is desirable that a decision be reached before the next meeting, voting electronically or by email shall be permissible.

Meetings (draft)



- The NGN shall hold an Annual General Meeting (AGM) in the last quarter of each year, where the elections for the Elected Officers shall take place.
- The AGM, if possible, should be held with the CIGRE Belgium NC meeting.
- The NGN AGM should be held prior to the Belgian NC AGM to allow for notification of elected officers.
- Meetings of the Steering Committee shall be held bi-monthly, with interim meetings as necessary. All NGN Members are invited to these meetings. It is expected that all Officers of the NGN shall attend the meetings of the Steering Committee.

Meetings (draft)



- Annual General Meeting (AGM) with elections yearly Q4.
- The AGM, if possible, should be held with a CIGRE Belgium NC meeting.
- Meetings of the Steering Committee shall be held bi-monthly, with interim meetings as necessary. All NGN Members are invited to these meetings. It is expected that all Officers of the NGN shall attend the meetings of the Steering Committee.
